<b>Test focus &amp; objectives</b>	Main idea, Specific information, Opinion (of the writer), Meaning from context, Simple Inference, Reference
<b>Text types</b>	Academic texts on a variety of topics, magazine / newspaper articles, blogs, reviews, reports, short story, letters, brochures.
