### Who can register to summer school?

\* The students who successfully finished module 2-A2 (ELL module 3 -B1) in the last period of prep program. The students who failed module 2-A2 (ELL module 3-B1) in the last period due to absenteeism or grade CANNOT attend summer school.

\*The students who failed module 3-B1 (ELL module 4 -B1+) in the last period of prep program due to absenteeism or grade can attend summer school.

**Absenteeism:** 40 hours. You will fail the level if you have 41 hours or more absenteeism. Absence-fail students cannot take EMT, which means they cannot succeed English Prep Program.

**Punctuality:** Latecomers are not admitted until a break time so students are expected to attend classes on time.
