### WRITING

<b>Test focus &amp; objectives</b>	To write a well-developed opinion paragraph.
<b>Answer format</b>	Candidates write their paragraph on a separate writing exam sheet.
<b>Marking</b>	20% of the exam

### SPEAKING

<b>Content &amp; task types</b>	<b>Task 1:</b> Candidates answer some questions on familiar topics. <b>Task 2:</b> Candidates are given a statement and discuss their ideas.
<b>Test focus &amp; objectives</b>	To answer questions on his/her opinions, experiences, feelings, reactions, dreams, hopes, and ambitions. To explain his/her ideas on a topic given.
<b>Answer format</b>	Candidates answer the questions and express their opinions.
<b>Marking</b>	20% of the exam
