<b>Test focus &amp; objectives</b>	Main idea, Specific information, Opinion (of the writer), Meaning from context, Simple Reference, Basic Inference
<b>Text types</b>	Newspaper /magazine articles, fiction, e-mails/letters, interviews, simple questionnaires, narratives, descriptions, notices & signs.
<b>Length of texts</b>	Approximately 250-300 words per text.
<b>Answer format</b>	Candidates mark their answers on the exam paper
<b>Marking</b>	25% of the Midterm
