Text types	Newspaper /magazine articles, fiction, e-mails/letters, interviews, simple questionnaires, narratives, descriptions.

WRITING	
Test focus & objectives	To write a short and simple paragraph on the given topic.
Answer format	Candidates write their paragraph on a separate writing exam sheet by using related grammatical structures and a variety of vocabulary items.
Marking	20% of the exam

SPEAKING	
Content & Task Types	Task 1: Candidates answer some basic questions about themselves. Task 2: Candidates answer some questions on familiar topics.
Test focus & objectives	To answer questions on his/her opinions, experiences and feelings by using related grammatical structures and a variety of vocabulary items.
Answer format	Candidates answer the questions and express their opinions.
Marking	20% of the exam
