<b>Content &amp; Task Types</b>	<b>Task 1:</b> A text followed by multiple choice questions <b>Task 2:</b> A text followed by multiple matching questions (matching paragraphs with headings) <b>Task 3:</b> A gapped text followed by multiple choice questions
<b>Number of questions</b>	15 in total
<b>Test focus &amp; objectives</b>	Main idea, Specific information, Opinion (of the writer), Meaning from context, Simple Inference, Reference, Coherence
<b>Text types</b>	Academic texts on a variety of topics, magazine / newspaper articles, blogs, reviews, reports, short story, letters, brochures.
<b>Length of texts</b>	Approximately 350-450 words per text.
<b>Answer format</b>	Candidates mark their answers
<b>Marking</b>	18% of the ELT



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LISTENING	
<b>Content and Task Types</b>	<b>Task 1:</b> Table / Note Completion <b>Task 2:</b> A text followed by multiple choice questions <b>Task 3:</b> A text followed by multiple matching questions (matching speakers with statements)
<b>Number of questions</b>	Approximately 15 questions
<b>Test focus &amp; objectives</b>	Main idea, Specific information, Opinion (of the writer), Meaning from context, Inference
<b>Text types</b>	Simple presentation or lectures, discussions, podcasts, radio programmes, interviews, narratives.
<b>Length of texts</b>	Approximately 3-4 minutes
<b>Answer format</b>	Candidates mark and write their answers
<b>Marking</b>	18% of the ELT



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USE OF ENGLISH	
<b>Content &amp; Task Types</b>	Some texts followed by multiple choice questions
<b>Number of questions</b>	Approximately 20 questions in total
<b>Test focus &amp; objectives</b>	Grammar & Vocabulary
<b>Text types</b>	Short academic texts on a variety of topics, short stories, magazine/newspaper articles, blogs, etc.
<b>Answer format</b>	Candidates mark their answers
<b>Marking</b>	24% of the ELT

WRITING	
<b>Content</b>	A problem-solution paragraph
<b>Test focus &amp; objectives</b>	To write a well-developed paragraph
<b>Answer format</b>	Candidates write their answers on the exam paper
<b>Marking</b>	20% of the ELT
