Task Types	Interactive discussion: 2-3-minute individual discussion. Question answer with the examiner Speech on a topic: 2-4-minute speech by the candidate on the given topic/question			
Marks	Candidates are assessed on their performance throughout the test by using SFL speaking exam criteria

PART I				
Task type and	An individual discussion from the candidate based on the questions given			
Format	by the examiner.			
	The candidates answer a series of questions posed by the examiner. The candidate can be given several seconds before answering to organize his/her ideas. The questions vary from personal ones to general idea questions on everyday life/general culture.			
Focus	Social interaction			
Timing	Max. 4 minutes (in total): 2-4 mins stating views and giving details			
PART II				
Task type and	A short speech by the candidate on the given statement or question.			
Format	NAME II - Ale a constitue de constitue de la c			
	While the candidate gives his/her view and comments on the topic, the interlocutor does not involve in the conversation; he/she only sets the task.			
	The interlocutor might help the candidate to start his/her speech by			
	changing the question/statement or asking a follow-up question only if the candidate cannot start his/her speech due to unfamiliarity with the topic.			
Focus	Organising a larger unit of discourse, expressing and justifying opinions, developing topics.			
Timing	Max. 4 minutes (in total): 2-4 mins stating views and supporting/justifying his/her opinion.
