Test focus & objectives	To write a short and simple paragraph on the given topic.	
Answer format	Candidates write their paragraph on a separate writing exam sheet.

SPEAKING	
Content & task types	Task 1: Candidates answer some basic questions about themselves.Task 2: Candidates answer some questions on familiar topics.
Test focus & objectives	To answer questions on his/her opinions, experiences, feelings, reactions, dreams, hopes, and ambitions. To explain his/her ideas on a topic given.
Answer format	Candidates answer the questions and express their opinions.
Marking	20% of the exam
