A changing climate endangers whole ecosystems and entire species. Scientists are only beginning to learn the impact of global warming on the world's biodiversity hotspots - rainforests, wetlands, and coral reefs. The World Wide Fund for Nature (WWF) says much of the Amazon rainforest and Australian Great Barrier Reef could be destroyed by unchecked global warming in the coming decades. According to a recent UN assessment, if global warming boosts average temperatures between 1.5 and 2.5 degrees Celsius, 20-30 percent of the earth's plant and animal species will face extinction. Most climate scientists think such warming is probable. We could lose countless species of plants, insects, and smaller animals, as well as some of our favorite mammals, including polar bears, whose habitats are literally melting away. Climate change will also affect basic environmental "services" provided by these ecosystems. Forests and marshes are **vital** for air purification, fresh water, and regulation of the climate. Coral reefs are important breeding grounds for fish. Once they are gone, the quality of life declines.

If you travel by air often enough, sooner or later your luggage will fly off in another direction.
