

If you travel by air often enough, sooner or later your luggage will fly off in another direction. As a result, you will be left temporarily - or maybe even permanently - without your clothes and whatever else you packed for your trip. In Britain, of all the customer complaints received at the airports last year, twelve percent were about baggage problems. In the United States as well, only flight delays and cancellations are more common than customers' complaints about thefts from their luggage or the fact that their suitcase did not arrive with them at their final destination. In ninety-eight percent of the reported cases passengers get their missing luggage back very quickly. Nevertheless, if the identification tag has come off your bag, it can very easily get lost. If, in addition, you have forgotten to put luggage labels on it or something inside it which links it to you, the airline will have great difficulty in identifying it as yours, even if they manage to find it. Finally, if your unlabelled luggage goes to one airport and you fly to **another**, the chances of your never seeing it again are very high indeed.
