WRITING	
Test focus & objectives	To write a well-developed problem solution essay
Answer format	Candidates write their essay on a separate writing exam sheet.
Marking	20% of the exam

SPEAKING	
Content & task types	Task 1: Candidates answer some questions on familiar issues. Task 2: Candidates are given a statement and discuss their ideas.
Test focus & objectives	To answer questions on his/her opinions, experiences, feelings, reactions, dreams, hopes, and ambitions. To explain his/her ideas on a topic given.
Answer format	Candidates answer the questions and express their opinions.
Marking	20% of the exam
